RULES AND RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE AND ETHICS BOARD

October 17, 2018

The Rules and Resolutions Committee and Ethics Board met on Wednesday, October 17, 2018, at 4:00 p.m. in the County Board Room, located on the third floor of the Courthouse, 181 West Seminary Street, Richland Center, Wisconsin.

Committee members present included: Dave Turk, Chad Cosgrove, Ed Pulvermacher and Jayme Walsh. (Don Seep was absent.)

Also present were: Victor Vlasak, County Clerk; Ben Southwick, Corporation Counsel; Jason Marshall, MIS Administrator; and Myranda Culver and Angie Rizner, Health and Human Services.

Committee Chair Turk called the meeting to order.

The Clerk verified that the meeting was properly noticed. Copies of the agenda were emailed to all Rules and Resolutions Committee members; a copy was posted on the Courthouse Bulletin Board and County web site; a copy was faxed to The Richland Observer; and copies were emailed to Fruit Broadcasting, LLC and County Department Heads.

The second resolution amends the Rules of the Board by reducing the per diem paid for attendance at meetings of the County Board and meetings of boards or committees and the time of day that County Board sessions will be held.
